Short Course for Macedonian Speakers

Are you a person who can speak Macedonian but have never learned to read and write in Macedonian? If so, you may be interested to know that the Macedonian Community Language School has developed a short reading and writing course for adult Macedonian speakers. The course is aimed at familiarising Macedonian speakers with the Macedonian alphabet which will enable speakers to read and write too. The course will be held over two classes in total that will run for 3.5 hours and take place on Saturday, 18 April 2015 and Saturday, 2 May 2015 (9.00am - 12.30pm).
